## 15th Annual St. Vrain Invitational Cross Country Meet

The 15th annual St. Vrain Invitational cross country meet is scheduled for **Saturday, September 12th** and is co-hosted by Lyons and Longmont High Schools. The meet takes place at Lyons high school and uses the Bohn Park parking area and fields south of the dog park. Over 60 high school teams and 35 middle school teams will be competing. The races will begin at 8 am and will affect much of Bohn Park, the Dog Park and the Parking Areas until 1 pm.



The Buffalo Bicycle Classic will be coming through Lyons on **Sunday, September 13th**, 2015. This scholarship fundraising bike ride benefits high merit students at the University of Colorado who exhibit financial need. Since 2003, the ride has awarded more than 2 million dollars in scholarships.
