TOWN HALL AND LIBRARY ART SHOWS

"The Persistence of Art in Lyons - Tandem Art Shows March Forth"

With clear sailing hopefully soon on the horizon, the LAHC dares to plot their future quarterly Lyons Regional Library and Town Hall Art Shows' scheduling with this COVID caveat: *If conditions resurface and preclude any public opening receptions, shows will be dismantled and hung as scheduled (with precautionary measures in place) and then safely presented online for public viewing.*

The LAHC's Lyons Regional Library series celebrates invited individuals, duos or trios of regional artists. The LAHC and the Library collaborated on the purchase, placement and installation of professional rigging from which all 2D art hangs. Any 3D art will be displayed only in designated spots atop specified bookcases and such.

The invited artists are expected to provide and place their own placards with title, size/medium, artist name, city/state, pricing, preferred means of contact, website if desired, etc., and all artwork should have this same information on its reverse side.

Artists (or their designated representative) are expected to participate in the hanging, planning of their show's opening reception, and dismantling. The proposed moving forward 2021- 2023 Quarterly Regional Library Show series is slated as follows with exact installation / dismantling times to be mutually arranged with Library staff, the artist(s), and LAHC installer(s):

The intent hereafter is to follow a planning matrix that will keep content varied and interesting at both venues, while including as many area artists as possible.

For example, the first LAHC Library show each year might always include a duo of artists working in two different genres — such as photography, graphics or drawing -- plus a 3D ceramic artist; the second show might annually showcase the work of high school seniors (limited perhaps to those intending to pursue art-related studies in their post-secondary schooling) along with a local senior artist (age 55 and over); the third show could predictably feature one or two painters of different ilks -- plus a 3D sculptor or woodworker; the fourth annual show might be a display of written words, collage, assemblage, collaborations, and/or mosaic creations.

The LAHC's traditional quarterly Town Hall Art Show series in the Shirley F. Johnson Council Chambers room are themed shows (wall art only) that are open to all community-friendly interpretations of a pre-announced theme and to all ages, abilities and mediums.

Lyons area artists may submit up to five ready-to-wall-hang pieces for the Town Hall shows. Works may include but are not limited to paintings, photography, computer graphics, collage, prose, poetry, printing, wall sculpture, and cartoons.

The LAHC reserves the right to refuse work deemed inappropriate for public (all ages) viewing in a public place, work that is not ready to wall hang or be properly displayed, and/or work that for whatever reason may be considered unsafe for handling by our volunteers.

At the designated drop-off time, artists will be provided with a sign-off sheet and placard for each piece — upon which artists will add the title, size/medium, artist name, city/state, pricing, preferred means of contact, website if desired, etc., and all artwork should also have this same information on its reverse side.

Art may only be picked-up on the designated dismantle date at the designated time. No exceptions.

The LAHC hopes to create a planning matrix for these shows as well to keep folks creating all year long for the various pre-announced and predictable themes (yet open enough for varied interpretations & completion by artists of all ages and abilities).

For instance, the first show each year might always celebrate “*Art Created by the Kiddos of Lyons;*” the second open-to-everyone show might annually showcase “*Lyons Means _____ To Me;*” the third show could predictably feature “*Wonders of Summers in the Rocky Mountains;*” the fourth annual show might be a display of, “*Gifts, Glee & Glitter*”

The plan is that the opening receptions for all four of the quarterly Town Hall Art Shows will coincide with the four Lyons Regional Library Shows’ opening receptions. Artists, guests & other attendees will be encouraged to flow between the two nearby venues. Any food/drinks/music/guest speakers on these evenings will be hosted at the Library location and jointly planned for by the LAHC and artist(s) showcased at the Library.

These tandem opening receptions will all be held on designated Wednesdays from 5:30 - 7. If any local musicians, performers or culinary purveyors are interested in exploring what providing entertainment, appetizers and/or beverages at these events might look like, please contact Brianna Hoyt (bhoyt@townoflyons.com). For example, in the past, Oskar Blues kindly supported these LAHC’s events with finger foods in exchange for promotion and encouragement for event attendees to dine at their local restaurant.

The LAHC very much appreciates and encourages a 10-20% donation from any sales of art that are converted during the course of or resulting from either of the show series. These funds are critical to achieving the commission’s goals for expansion of local arts opportunities. All pieces in either show series must remain in place until the show’s designated dismantle pick-up date and time.

This is a lot to take in. But please take note, plan to attend (*if all systems are “GO”*), create pieces for the shows, encourage others to do likewise, and invest in locally-made creations.
