

**RESOLUTION 2011-13
TOWN OF LYONS, COLORADO**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF LYONS, BOULDER COUNTY, COLORADO,
TO IMPLEMENT A REBATE PROGRAM FOR INSTALLATION OF PRESSURE REDUCING VALVES
FOR INDIVIDUAL DOMESTIC WATER SYSTEMS.**

WHEREAS, The Town of Lyons provides the delivery system for domestic water to the point of connection of individual taps for private services to buildings, and

WHEREAS, The Town of Lyons owns, maintains and operates the domestic water system in accordance with local, state and federal standards and has implemented measures to provide a reasonable and customary delivery system, and

WHEREAS, The Town of Lyons desires to be a good steward of the total domestic water system not only within the ownership of the Town but also to the point of delivery, and

WHEREAS, the Town acknowledges that in being a good steward, it is important to minimize losses in systems in key points and to have a total system per recognized standards and those key points remaining include individual building pressure reducing valves, and

WHEREAS, some of the buildings built in Lyons were completed without pressure reducing valves and have been impacted by and impacted the Towns domestic water system, and

WHEREAS, the Town of Lyons has identified a rebate program that will allow the individual building owner to secure services of a private licensed plumber for installation of a pressure reducing valve and then be reimbursed subject to conditions of the rebate program, for a portion of the total cost of the installation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED that upon the date of Adoption of this Ordinance, the Town of Lyons will enact the pressure reducing valve rebate program.
